La Ordenanza Nº 17, sancionada por el Honorable Concejo Deliberante con fecha 6 de febrero de 1984;

El Intendente Municipal en uso de sus facultades

~~DECRETA~~

ARTICULO 1º: Promúlgase la Ordenanza Nº 17, sancionada por el Honorable Concejo /
Deliberante con fecha 6 de febrero de 1984, cuyo texto se transcribe
a continuación:

"VISTO

"El estado de emergencia que presentan ciertos sectores de la costa atlánti-
ca del Partido de Mar Chiquita debido a la erosión permanente por acción del mar,

"El peligro que corren los lotes en esas zonas y en consecuencia las cons-/
trucciones levantadas en las mismas,

"Que es deber municipal velar por el bienestar de la comunidad y que ello ne-
cesariamente implica resguardar por medio de ordenanzas o decretos en contra de /
pérdidas de vida o material en cuanto esté a su alcance,

"Que en esta zona el mar ya ha destruido una vivienda, resultando necesaria
entonces proceder en resguardo de la pérdida de otras viviendas; y

"CONSIDERANDO

"Que a tales efectos, esta comuna se encuentra avocada al estudio intensivo
del problema y al encuentro de una solución definitiva del mismo, para lo cual /
se han solicitado a la Provincia obras a realizar tendientes a finalizar la ero-
sión de la costa;

"Que dichas obras, algunas en ejecución y otras a ejecutar, hacen necesarias
medidas excepcionales de seguridad de breve duración;

"Por ello,

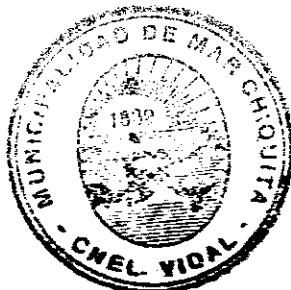
"EL HONORABLE CONCEJO DELIBERANTE EN USO DE SUS FACULTADES, SANCIONA CON FUERZA DE
"ORDENANZA

"ARTICULO 1º: Suspéndase la aprobación de todo plano de obra edilicia a realizarse
" en parcelas aledañas a la costa atlántica del Partido de Mar Chiqui-
ta por el término de 90 días, cuya individualización se determina en el anexo ad-
junto a la presente ordenanza y que forma parte de la misma.

"ARTICULO 2º: La presente Ordenanza entrará en vigencia a partir del día siguien-
te al de la fecha de su publicación.

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The Commission on the Status of Women, established in 1946, was the first international body to deal with the status of women. It was created by the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations. The Commission's mandate was to study the status of women in all countries and to make recommendations to the United Nations on ways to improve it. The Commission has since held numerous sessions and has produced a wealth of reports and recommendations on a wide range of issues affecting women, including education, employment, health, and family life.

On 15 December 1979, the Commission adopted the Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination Against Women (CEDAW). This landmark treaty was the first international human rights instrument to be devoted exclusively to the rights of women. It defines discrimination against women and sets out a comprehensive list of measures that states parties must take to eliminate it. CEDAW has since been ratified by over 110 countries and is widely regarded as the most important international instrument for the advancement of women's rights.
